EUROPEAN UNION (EU) WASTE RECYCLING PROGRAM

Electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) and batteries contain materials, components, and substances that may be hazardous and present a risk to human health and the environment if not handled correctly. If you are an EU customer, you play an important role in recycling your waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) when you take it out of service.

IDENTIFYING EQUIPMENT

Equipment marked with a crossed-out wheeled bin is electrical and electronic equipment.



This symbol indicates that waste electrical and electronic equipment and batteries should not be discarded with unseparated municipal waste but must be collected separately.
