OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE OR WIN.

1. **CONTEST PERIOD:** The AWS BugBust League 2021 (“Contest”) begins on or about 24, June, 2021 at 12:00:01 AM (Midnight) Greenwich Mean Time (“GMT”) and ends on or about 31, October, 2021 at 11:59:59 PM GMT (“Contest Period”). **THIS CONTEST MAY BE CANCELED OR POSTPONED BY SPONSOR, IN FULL OR IN PART, AT ANY TIME, FOR FRAUD PREVENTION, SYSTEM SECURITY, OR FORCE MAJEURE REASONS, INCLUDING FOR REASONS DUE TO THE ONGOING PANDEMIC (E.G., CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19) IN SUCH CASE THE ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA EMAIL OR AN ANNOUNCEMENT ON THE CONTEST WEBSITE.**

2. **ELIGIBILITY:** The Contest is open to those who meet the following eligibility requirements:
 - i. To participate as a BugBust administrator, you need an AWS Account and a player account, which can be set up at <https://console.aws.amazon.com/codeguru/bugbust/>.
 - ii. To participate as a BugBust participant, you need a player account, which can be set up at bugbust.aws.
 - iii. You must be able to operate an Internet browser and be the minimum age listed below based on the country or region in which you are located (if the minimum age listed is below the age of majority in your jurisdiction of residence, you must have consent to participate from your parent or legal guardian):

- iv. The following are excluded from entering any part of the Contest:
 1. Employees of the Sponsor, Administrator, and their respective affiliates and subsidiaries or anyone professionally associated with this Contest.
 2. Residents of countries that are on the USA banned trading lists: the Balkans, Belarus, Myanmar/Burma, the Ivory Coast, Cuba, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Iran, Iraq, Lebanon, Liberia, Libya, North Korea, Somalia, Sudan, Zimbabwe.

3. Residents of Quebec, Canada.
4. Residents of the following provinces of Argentina: Mendoza, Córdoba, Neuquén and Tierra del Fuego.
5. Anyone subject to OFAC sanctions, including any individual on the OFAC SDN list and any individuals residing in Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Syria, or the Crimea Region of Ukraine.

Before participating, entrants that are under 18 years of age, or the age of majority in their jurisdiction of residence if above 18, must show these Official Rules to their parents or legal guardians and receive their permission to agree to these Official Rules, and participate in the Contest. Where parental permission is required, entrants must be able to provide evidence that their parent or guardian has consented to their participation in the Contest, or if required, execute documentation that confirms this fact in a form reasonably acceptable to Sponsor.

Entrants must ensure that participation (and acceptance of any prize awarded) is lawful in accordance with the laws of the country or region in which they are a resident. Void where prohibited by law. All local laws and regulations apply. Employees of Sponsor, Administrator, and each of their respective parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates, advertising and promotion agencies (collectively, “Contest Entities”) and each of their immediate family members (e.g., spouse, parent, child, sibling, and their respective spouses and the “steps” of each, regardless of where they reside) and persons living in the same household of each, whether or not related, are not eligible to enter or win. Participation constitutes entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules. Interpretation of the Official Rules will be objective and based on principles in good faith and Sponsor’s decisions and interpretations, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest. Winning a prize is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein. Entrants and/or potential winners may be required to provide proof of identification and eligibility as required by Sponsor or Administrator.

3. HOW TO PARTICIPATE:

An eligible AWS BugBust administrator can create a BugBust event, by following the prompts at <https://console.aws.amazon.com/codeguru/bugbust/> (“**Contest Site**”). You can invite players to your event, via an email, after you create the event and Amazon CodeGuru identifies bugs for your players to fix. Only players that are invited by the administrator will be able to access and participate in the event.

To join a BugBust event as a player, eligible individuals will:

- 1) Choose the link from the invitation email from your BugBust administrator.
- 2) On the AWS management console, use your [IAM credentials](#) to log into the BugBust event details page.
- 3) On the BugBust event details page, choose “Join Event.”

Eligible players earn points by fixing bugs or improving the performance of the application in the uploaded code. To let players fix bugs, the administrator specifies a repository analysis for the event in Amazon CodeGuru Reviewer in the administrator’s AWS account and Region. All issues Amazon CodeGuru Reviewer finds during the analysis will be made available to the players as bugs to claim and fix. To let players improve the performance of an application, the administrator specifies a profiling group for the event in Amazon CodeGuru Profiler in the administrator’s AWS account and Region. Amazon CodeGuru Profiler will make all

performance issues it finds during its analysis available to players as bugs which will be available for players to claim and fix. Once an administrator makes these bugs available for players to claim and fix, a player can claim up to 3 bugs at a time to try to fix, however if the player does not fix a claimed bug within 2 hours, the bug will be made available for other players to claim.

For both bugs and performance enhancements, a player creates a pull request with the code changes that address the issue that the player attempted to fix. After the updated code is merged, Amazon CodeGuru Reviewer and Amazon CodeGuru Profiler analyze the updated code base. If, at this point, AWS BugBust no longer detects the original issue that the player attempted to fix, the issue is considered fixed and points are awarded to the player. After a player checks in code to improve the performance of a profiling group, the BugBust event administrator evaluates the performance effect of the checked-in code. After the administrator starts the evaluation, the system will award points based on the complexity of fixed bugs and the level of performance improvement on a profiling group, in accordance with the table below.

Each players' points will be reflected in both the event leaderboard and the global leaderboard. To see the event leaderboard, select "Leaderboard" on the event's page. To see the global leaderboard, the player logs into the portal (bugbust.aws) and clicks on "Standings."

- 4. WINNER DETERMINATION:** At the end of the Contest Period, the top ten (10) individual player accounts with the most points on the global leaderboard will be deemed the potential grand prize winners. In addition, the top ten (10) organizations that host BugBust events with the most points will also be eligible to select two individuals to win a grand prize. The rules and number of points may vary per event and will be communicated online at <https://awsleague.aws/rules-and-prizes/>. When a developer participant accumulates a specific number of points, they will be eligible to receive a prize as indicated below:

5. PRIZES:

A. Grand Prizes (30 total): Each of the 30 grand prize is a trip to re:Invent 2021 in Las Vegas, NV USA. (“Grand Prize”). Each Grand Prize includes round-trip coach / economy class air transportation from winner’s nearest international airport to Las Vegas, NV USA, for winner only (except as otherwise set forth in this section), five (5) nights standard hotel accommodations (single room/double occupancy), ground transportation to/from airport and hotel, \$350 USD total for meals and expenses, and 1 ticket to re:Invent. If a winner is a resident of Hong Kong or the United Arab Emirates, the 350 USD allowance for food and travel will be provided via a pre-paid credit card. If winner is a minor in their place of residence, winner must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. Travel will be provided to the minor winner’s parent or legal guardian by the Sponsor on the same basis as for the winner. Trip must be taken on dates specified by Sponsor. If applicable, winner and parent/legal guardian must travel on the same itinerary. If a winner resides within a 100-mile radius of destination, ground transportation may be provided in lieu of air transportation, and no compensation will be provided for any difference in prize value. All elements of Grand Prizes (including airline tickets, hotel accommodation, and any pre-paid cards) are non-refundable and non-transferable. Each winner and parent/legal guardian (if applicable) are responsible for having valid travel documents including visas, government identification and/or passports. Winners are responsible for all travel expenses not included herein, including but not limited to airline baggage fees, gratuities, meals, and any other incidental costs or expenses related to participation in this prize. If applicable (and if permitted under applicable law), parent/legal guardian of minor winners must sign and return a travel liability release before travel will be booked. Each winner and his or her parent/legal guardian (if applicable) hereby acknowledges that Sponsor has not and will not obtain or provide travel insurance or any other form of insurance for any part of the trip. Each winner, and/or their parent/legal guardian, will be required to provide a major credit card upon hotel check-in, and all in-room charges will be charged to the credit card. Any damage to the room will be the responsibility of the winner. The Contest Entities bear no responsibility if any event, element or detail of a prize is canceled, postponed or becomes unavailable for any reason and Sponsor will promptly notify the affected winner of any cancellation, postponement, or unavailability. If any event, element or detail of the prize is canceled, postponed, or otherwise become unavailable, the Contest Entities shall have no obligation to the winner aside from providing the remaining portion of the prize, minus any unavailable event, element or detail (except where prohibited by law). The approximate retail value (“ARV”) of each Grand Prize is: \$4,000.00 USD. There will be thirty (30) Grand Prizes available in this Contest.

B. 10,000 points earned (200): The first 200 eligible participants that earn a total of 10,000 points will receive a BugBust resin trophy. The ARV of each First Prize is \$60 USD.

C. 2,000 points earned (2,000): The first 2,000 eligible participants that earn a total of 2,000 points will receive a BugBust hooded sweatshirt. The ARV of each Second Prize is \$27 USD.

D. 100 points earned (4,000): The first 4,000 eligible participants that earn a total of 100

points will receive a BugBust t-shirt. The ARV of each Third Prize is \$12 USD.

E. Prize Conditions: Each participant may receive a maximum of one of each prize type during the Contest Period. If a potential prize winner is NOT a legal resident of one of the following countries or regions; the United States, Canada (excluding Quebec), Argentina, Australia, China, France, the Federal Republic of Germany, Hong Kong, India, Ireland, Israel, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Netherlands, New Zealand, Poland, Singapore, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, Thailand, United Arab Emirates, or the United Kingdom, their ability to claim and receive a prize will be subject to local laws and restrictions of their place of residence. As a result of any local laws and restrictions, potential prize winners may not be eligible to receive a prize and prize will therefore be forfeited. In the event a prize is forfeited for any reason, including for non-compliance with these Official Rules, no additional prize will be awarded. Prizes will not be redeemed or exchanged for cash, except where required by law. In no event will more than the stated number of prizes be awarded. No prize substitution or exchange will be allowed, except by the Contest Entities, who reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value for any reason, subject to the exclusions outlined in Section 5(A) of these Official Rules (for Germany entrants, only in the case of unavailability of the prize).

6. HOW TO CLAIM A PRIZE: At the conclusion of Contest Period or upon accumulating the required number of points, potential winners will be notified via e-mail using the information disclosed at the time of registration and provided further details to claim their prize. They will be directed to a prize redemption portal to complete the required information in order to claim the prize. All information and required documentation must be completed and submitted in the prize redemption portal within 30 days. Before being declared a verified winner, where permitted by applicable law, the potential Grand Prize winners, or in the case of minors, their parents or legal guardians, must complete, sign, and submit an Affidavit of Eligibility/Liability & Publicity Release and a tax acknowledgement form ("Affidavit"), within fourteen (14) business days from the date it is e-mailed to the potential winner by the Administrator. Potential winners are subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules and/or applicable law. Failure to provide all required information and complete all of the other required activities within the stated time period may result in forfeiture of winner's right to claim a prize, and in the case of grand prize winners may result in the prize being awarded to an alternate winner, if time permits. If permitted under local law, the potential winners may be subject to a background check before the prize is awarded. Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify the potential winner based on the results of such background check if Sponsor determines in its sole discretion that awarding the prize to any such individual might reflect negatively on the Sponsor. Further, winners are responsible for their behavior whilst taking the prize. The Sponsor reserves the right in its absolute discretion to exclude a winner from participation in any aspect of the prize if the winner fails to comply with the directions of the Sponsor or any companies associated with the prize or if a winner acts in a manner that is dangerous to themselves or to the public or is, in the opinion of the Sponsor, anti-social, infringing, or disparaging in any manner or which causes a disturbance or nuisance to others. Upon verification of eligibility, the winner will be contacted regarding prize fulfillment and Sponsor/Administrator will coordinate travel arrangements, if applicable. If a potential winner is found to be ineligible, declines to accept the prize, or any winner notification is returned as undeliverable; the potential winner cannot travel on the specified dates; the potential winner fails to respond to a winner notification within the timeframe specified in such winner notification; or if a potential winner does not answer the initial notification, the prize may be forfeited. If a prize is unclaimed, unredeemed or any portion thereof returned as undeliverable,

it will be forfeited. Un-awarded prizes will remain the property of the Sponsor. Prizes are not transferable and includes only the items specifically listed as part of the prize. Approximate retail value is as of the time these Official Rules were printed and the value of the prize may fluctuate based on winner location and cost of travel. The winners are not entitled to any difference between the ARV and the actual value of the prize at the time the prize is awarded. If, after a good-faith attempt, Sponsor/Administrator is unable to award or deliver a prize, that prize will not be re-awarded.

FOR US PERSONS, THE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF THE PRIZE AMOUNT WILL BE REPORTED ON IRS FORM 1099-MISC AND ISSUED TO THE RECIPIENT. TAX IDENTITY INFORMATION WILL BE COLLECTED BY COMPLETING IRS FORM W-9. FOR NON-US PERSONS, THE FAIR MARKET VALUE, CASH EQUIVALENT AND TAXES PAID RELATING TO PRIZES AWARDED ARE SUBJECT TO IRS FORM 1042-S REPORTING. TAX IDENTITY INFORMATION WILL BE COLLECTED BY COMPLETING IRS FORM W-8.

Each winner shall be solely responsible for payment of any and all applicable federal, state, provincial and local taxes for the prize won and customs clearance fees, if any. Each winner may also be required to sign and return certain tax documentation. Where applicable, the Sponsor may require winners to provide additional tax information, as required by law.

7. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:** By participating in this Contest, entrants agree that the Contest Entities and each of their respective affiliates, subsidiaries, representatives, consultants, contractors, legal counsel, advertising, public relations, promotional, fulfillment and marketing agencies, website providers and each their respective officers, directors, stockholders, employees, representatives, designees and agents ("Released Parties") are, to the extent permitted by law, not responsible for: (i) lost, late, incomplete, stolen, misdirected, undeliverable e-mail notifications, or postal mail; (ii) any computer, satellite, cable, network, electronic or Internet hardware or software malfunctions, failures, connections, or availability; (iii) garbled, corrupt or jumbled transmissions, service provider/Internet/website/UseNet accessibility, availability or traffic congestion; (iv) any technical, mechanical, printing or typographical or other error; (v) the incorrect or inaccurate capture of registration information or the failure to capture, or loss of, any such information; (vi) any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, technical error, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to the Contest; (vii) any injury or damage, whether personal or property (or any COVID-19 related illness), to entrants or to any person's computer related to or resulting from participating in the Contest and/or accepting or using a prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law; (viii) entries that are late, forged, lost, misplaced, misdirected, tampered with, incomplete, deleted, damaged, or otherwise not in compliance with the Official Rules; and (ix) for any loss (including, without limitation, indirect, special or consequential loss or loss of profits), expense or damage which is suffered or sustained (whether or not arising from any person's negligence) in connection with this Contest or accepting or using a prize, except for any liability which cannot be excluded by law. Further, the Contest Entities are not responsible for any undelivered messages or e-mails, including without limitation, e-mails that are not received because of an entrant's privacy or spam filter settings that may divert any winner notification or other Contest related e-mail to a spam or junk folder. Nothing in this section shall exclude the Contest Entities, or their respective agents or representatives from liability for death or personal injury caused by the Contest Entities' gross negligence, willful misconduct, or for any other liability whose limitation is prohibited under applicable law of a participant's jurisdiction of residence.

By entering the Contest, each entrant agrees: (i) to be bound by these Official Rules, (ii) to the extent permitted by applicable law, to waive any rights to claim ambiguity with respect to these Official Rules; (iii) to the extent permitted by law, to waive all of their rights to bring any claim, action or proceeding against any of the Released Parties in connection with the Contest; and (iv) to the extent permitted by law, to forever and irrevocably agree to release and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any and all claims, lawsuits, judgments, causes of action, proceedings, demands, fines, penalties, liability, costs and expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) that may arise in connection with: (a) the Contest, including, but not limited to, any Contest-related activity or element thereof, participation or inability to participate in the Contest; (b) the violation of any third-party privacy, personal, publicity or proprietary rights; (c) acceptance, attendance at, receipt, travel related to, participation in, delivery of, possession, defects in, use, non-use, misuse, inability to use, loss, damage, destruction, negligence or willful misconduct in connection with the use of a prize (or any component thereof); (d) any change in the Contest or prizing (or any components thereof); (e) human error; (f) any wrongful, negligent, or unauthorized act or omission on the part of any of the Released Parties; (g) lost, late, stolen, misdirected, damaged or destroyed prizing (or any element thereof); or (h) the negligence or willful misconduct by entrant.

If, for any reason, the Contest is not capable of running as planned, or the integrity and or feasibility of the Contest is severely undermined by any event beyond the control of the Contest Entities, including but not limited to fire, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, satellite or equipment failure, riot or civil disturbance, war (declared or undeclared), terrorist threat or activity, or any federal, state, provincial or local government law, order, or regulation, order of any court or jurisdiction, infection by computer virus, unauthorized intervention, technical failures or other cause not reasonably within the control of the Contest Entities (each a "Force Majeure" event or occurrence), Sponsor/Administrator reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to abbreviate, cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Contest and/or proceed with the Contest, including the selection of winners in a manner it deems fair and reasonable, including the selection of winners from among eligible entries received prior to such event without any further obligation provided a sufficient number of eligible entries are received. If Sponsor/Administrator, in its discretion, elects to alter this Contest as a result of a Force Majeure event, a notice will be posted at the Website.

Entrants shall not provide any illegal content in the course of participating in the Contest.

WITHOUT LIMITING THE FOREGOING, UNLESS PROHIBITED BY LAW, EVERYTHING REGARDING THIS CONTEST, INCLUDING THE PRIZE, IS PROVIDED "AS IS" WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE OR NON-INFRINGEMENT.

For Hong Kong Residents Only: For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in this Agreement shall exclude or limit liability in relation to (i) death or personal injury caused by negligence or willful or reckless misconduct; (ii) any fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; and (iii) any other liability that cannot, as a matter of law, be limited or excluded.

8. DISPUTES: THIS CONTEST IS GOVERNED BY, AND WILL BE CONSTRUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH, THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, AND THE FORUM

AND VENUE FOR ANY DISPUTE SHALL BE IN THE COUNTY OF KING, WASHINGTON. THIS CHOICE OF LAW DOES NOT DEPRIVE THE ENTRANT OF THE PROTECTION AFFORDED UNDER THE LAWS OF THEIR JURISDICTION OF RESIDENCE AND SUCH PROVISIONS THAT CANNOT BE DEROGATED FROM BY AGREEMENT OR VIRTUE OF THE LAW OF THEIR JURISDICTIONS OF RESIDENCE. IF THE CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM IS NOT OTHERWISE RESOLVED THROUGH DIRECT DISCUSSIONS OR MEDIATION, IT SHALL THEN BE RESOLVED BY FINAL AND BINDING ARBITRATION ADMINISTERED BY JAMS IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS ARBITRATION RULES AND PROCEDURES OR SUBSEQUENT VERSIONS THEREOF (“JAMS RULES”). THE JAMS RULES FOR SELECTION OF AN ARBITRATOR SHALL BE FOLLOWED, EXCEPT THAT THE ARBITRATOR SHALL BE EXPERIENCED AND LICENSED TO PRACTICE LAW IN WASHINGTON. ALL PROCEEDINGS BROUGHT PURSUANT TO THIS PARAGRAPH WILL BE CONDUCTED IN KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON. THE REMEDY FOR ANY CLAIM SHALL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL DAMAGES, AND IN NO EVENT SHALL ANY PARTY BE ENTITLED TO RECOVER PUNITIVE, EXEMPLARY, CONSEQUENTIAL, STATUTORY, OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES, INCLUDING ATTORNEY’S FEES OR OTHER SUCH RELATED COSTS OF BRINGING A CLAIM, OR TO RESCIND THIS AGREEMENT OR SEEK INJUNCTIVE OR ANY OTHER EQUITABLE RELIEF. UNLESS PROHIBITED BY LAW, ANY DEMAND FOR ARBITRATION MUST BE FILED WITHIN ONE (1) YEAR OF THE TIME THE CAUSE OF ACTION ACCRUED, OR THE CAUSE OF ACTION SHALL BE FOREVER BARRED.

For French Entrants Only: ALL MANDATORY FRENCH LAW PROVISIONS WILL APPLY TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES. ANY AND ALL DISPUTES, CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THIS CONTEST OR THESE OFFICIAL RULES MAY BE RESOLVED BY BRINGING A CLAIM BEFORE THE COURTS HAVING JURISDICTION UNDER FRENCH LAW. THE ENTRANT MAY BRING A CLAIM BEFORE THE COURTS HAVING JURISDICTION WHERE THE ENTRANT OR THE SPONSOR IS DOMICILED.

For Irish Entrants Only: BOTH ENTRANTS AND THE CONTEST ENTITIES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR FORESEEABLE LOSS AND DAMAGE TO THE EXTENT CAUSED BY THE APPLICABLE PARTY.
